The collection of extraordinary works-of-art created by animals living at the zoo will be on display throughout the zoo's lobby and café. Viewing is free with regular zoo admission and for zoo members.

Members of the zoo's keeper staff have been working diligently with the animals under their

care to create the art featured in the 75-piece collection. The exhibition includes several pieces produced by trunks, paws, feet, hooves, scales, skin and, of course, brushes.

"It is exciting for us to once again showcase a wonderful selection of art and the results of this type of enrichment experience for our animals," said Ted Fox, zoo director. "The works represent many of the species in our animal collection. Each year, our visitors enjoy seeing artistic expressions created by our Asian elephants, siamang apes, large cats, primates, birds, domestic animals and reptiles – among many others."

At the conclusion of the "Art Gone Wild!" exhibition, an art auction will be held to raise funds to benefit the zoo's AAZK chapter. The auction is Friday, November 21 beginning at 6 p.m. at the zoo.

Admission is \$5 per person; children 6 and under are free. Admission includes non-alcoholic beverages and light appetizers; a cash bar will be available.
